

Hear from Anna, a Ukrainian who moved with her nine-year-old son

Anna:

My name is Anna. I am 31 years old, I am a psychologist by profession. I have a son, he is 9 years old. He will be going to the 4th grade and together we came from Odessa to Prague.

Interviewer:

What are three main actors that helped you find a job?

Anna:

The first is definitely communication. Everywhere I got to meet people: at trainings, at volunteering I met people, communicated what I needed to communicate what I can offer. Next from the factors is patience. Because the time is running out, and it is necessary not to give up, keep looking for options. And perhaps a third that helped me find the job—perhaps also from qualities, or from traits—perseverance, because I went, wrote, called many places.

What would you advise women who left their homes?

Create! Create joy around you! Create opportunities and help for other people around you. Multiply positive emotions, multiply the good in this world.
