

LNGFlow Dashboard April 2020

In April, LNG imports in China grew 1.06 MT—or 25 percent year on year compared to the 9 and 6 percent drops seen in January and February. Elsewhere in Asia, however, imports in Japan, Korea, and Taiwan (JKT) dropped to 9.6 MT—a 20 percent drop from March and a 4 percent decrease year on year. European imports are still up year on year at 7 percent, though this is significantly less than in previous months.

Global LNG supply reached 31 MT, the lowest level in ten months and a 6 percent decline from March. The decline in supply came from Qatar and Malaysia, which supplied 0.7 and 0.5 MT less than in March, respectively. Finally, US projects exported 4.3 MT, which was the lowest level in six months.
