3 Increasing the use of technology to automate certain tasks and enhance efficiency

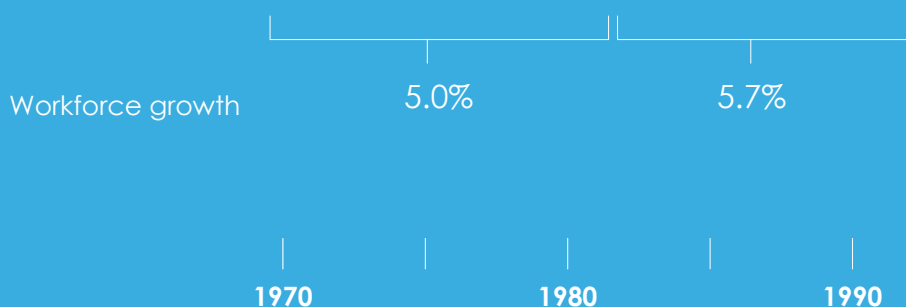


Other industries have done this

Legal industry example

Paralegals introduced in the legal industry (1971), though labor productivity remained low

Labor productivity in the legal industry rose dramatically while workforce continued to grow
